SUBJECT: OVERVIEW OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE SECOND-HAND SMOKE CONTROL ORDINANCE

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council receives and files this overview of the City's Comprehensive Second-Hand Smoke Control Ordinance.

BACKGROUND:

At the request of Council, this item has been agenzized for review.

The Comprehensive Second-Hand Smoke Control Ordinance went into effect on March 17, 2006. It was amended in January of 2008 to include second hand smoke control requirements for multifamily housing units. The purpose of the law was to:

- A. Protect the public health, safety and general welfare by prohibiting smoking in public places;
- B. Ensure a cleaner and more hygienic environment for the city;
- C. Strike a reasonable balance between smokers and nonsmokers;

- D. Recognize the right of residents and visitors to the city to be free from unwelcome second-hand smoke;
- E. Recognize the long-term health effects of inhaling vapors and effects of secondhand vapors from electronic (e) cigarettes.
