SUBJECT: REPORT ON UPDATE OF CALABASAS MUNICIPAL CODE AND TITLE 13 OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY CODE

MEETING DATE: OCTOBER 24, 2016

BACKGROUND:

Calabasas adopted the Los Angeles County Code as part of the incorporation process in 1991. While the Calabasas Municipal Code has been amended through the years, many sections of the Los Angeles County Code are still in effect.

DISCUSSION:

The City Council directed the PSC to review sections of the Municipal Code and LA County Code for possible revisions to the Municipal Code. Over a period of six meetings the PSC reviewed and edited LACC Title 13. The draft was then reviewed by the city attorney. On September 28, 2016 the city council adopted Ordinance 2016-338 adopting the changes recommended by the Public Safety Commission.
