

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-1205

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN BY CLARIFYING THAT THE CITY SHALL NOT EXPAND THE CURRENT FOOTPRINT OR FACILITIES OF GATES CANYON PARK.

WHEREAS, the City of Calabasas recognized the importance of parks, recreation and open space planning to enhance the lives of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the Calabasas Parks and Recreation Master Plan in recognition of the need for a comprehensive planning document that inventories parks and recreation facilities and recommends strategies for enhancing leisure opportunities for our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calabasas desires to address the concerns of the residents of Mountain View Estates about the expansion of Gates Canyon Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calabasas wishes to alleviate those concerns by amending the Parks and Recreation Master Plan to clarify that the City shall not expand the current footprint or facilities of Gates Canyon Park.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Calabasas approves that:

1. The Parks and Recreation Master Plan is hereby amended as follows: The City of Calabasas shall not expand the current footprint or facilities of Gates Canyon Park.
2. The Parks and Recreation Master Plan shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by Paragraph 1 of this Resolution.
3. Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) ("CEQA") and the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15000 et seq.), the City Council finds that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption of this resolution will have a significant effect on the environment. Therefore, the adoption of this resolution is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 (b)(3). Furthermore, the City Council has also determined that this resolution is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State Guidelines Sections 15307 (actions by regulatory

agencies for the protection of natural resources), and 15308 (actions by regulatory agencies for the protection of the environment).

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause the same to be processed in the manner required by law.
