Notice of Public Hearing and Availability of Initial Study/Environmental Assessment

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the City of Calabasas (City) have completed studies and issued an Initial Study/ Environmental Assessment (IS/EA) for the U.S. 101/ Lost Hills Road Overcrossing Replacement and Interchange Modification Project, along U.S. Highway 101 in the City of Calabasas. The proposed improvements would increase roadway widths, modify the existing northbound and southbound ramps, and replace the existing overcrossing with a new one designed with increased vertical clearance and current seismic safety standards.

A Public Hearing will be held to discuss the project on **February 28, 2012** from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the **City of Calabasas City Hall 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, CA**. Project staff will be available to discuss the project and to answer any questions about the proposed project.
