Subject: MULHOLLAND SCENIC CORRIDOR PHASE III PROJECT

Dear Residents:

Please distribute this information to the home owners in your association.

Per the contractor's scheduling and the project's specifications, work on this project is expected to begin on June 12, 2015 and end no later than February 16, 2016.

The Measure R/Mulholland Hwy. Phase III project will improve the corridor in these ways:

1. **Traffic Calming** Slowing vehicle speeds and providing safer pedestrian crossing areas.
2. **Improved School Drop-Off Areas**
Drop-off/Pick-up area better protected and provide additional room.
3. **Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements**
Pedestrian gap closure eliminated and bicycle facilities improved.
4. **Slope Stabilization Alternatives**
Retaining walls will help stabilize the hillside in the immediate area.
5. **Landscaping Improvements**
Landscaping will be consistent throughout the corridor.
6. **Emergency Access**
The modifications will be consistent and retain the corridor's emergency route elements.

Calabasas' Mulholland Hwy. Phase III project is primarily a safety and active transportation capacity enhancement project with the following specific features:

- School drop off/pick up area operations will be better protected and provide more maneuvering room, vehicular speeds will be reduced through various traffic calming features, active transportation modes will be improved with the elimination of a pedestrian gap closure and improved bicycle facilities, new retaining walls will help stabilize the hillside in the project's vicinity and all

modifications will be consistent and retain the corridor's emergency route elements.

While the project is in progress, temporary "No Parking" signs may be posted on the streets. The signs will be posted at least 24 hours before the actual work begins to provide notice to residents. Please have all vehicles removed from the street to protect them from damage by construction debris and to prevent interference with the planned work. Vehicles will have full access to all residences and businesses in the vicinity of the project during this construction. In case of inclement weather, it may be necessary to reschedule the CONTRACTOR's operation. You will be notified of any possible delays and the revised completion date.

Your cooperation will be appreciated during the construction period. Your patience will be rewarded with a safer, more beautiful corridor with many new amenities.
