## **RESOLUTION NO. 2001-673**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CITY OF CALABASAS CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) LOCAL IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, Section 15022 of the State CEQA Guidelines requires each public agency to develop its own procedures consistent with those guidelines; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act [Division 13 of the Public Resources Code of the State (beginning at Section 21000)], an environmental assessment has been made in accordance with the State CEQA Guidelines, and it has been determined that the proposed City CEQA Guidelines is Categorically Exempt as an action by a regulatory agency for the protection of the environment under Section 15308 of the State CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2000, the Environmental Commission reviewed the Guidelines and recommended adoption of the Guidelines and on February 8, 2001, the Planning Commission discussed and considered said proposed City Guidelines, and adopted Planning Commission Resolution No. 00-195 recommending to the City Council adoption of the City Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has discussed and considered said proposed City Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the local guidelines recognize the unique local environment and setting and are tailored to address our local air quality, flora and fauna issues and concerns; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the proposed City CEQA Implementation Guidelines are consistent with the requirements of the State CEQA Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS:

Section 1. The Calabasas Local CEQA Implementation Guidelines Exhibit "A" (attached) are adopted.

## Section 2. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision, section, paragraph, sentence or word of this Resolution, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences or words of this Resolution, and the application of such to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected thereby.

## Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution shall take effect 30 days after its passage and adoption pursuant to California Government Code Section 36937 and shall supersede any conflicting provision of any City of Calabasas resolution.

## Section 4. CERTIFICATION.

The City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause the same to be processed in the manner required by law.
