City Manager Dr. Gary Lysik Signs City of Calabasas Emergency Proclamation

In his role as Director of Emergency Services for the City of Calabasas, City Manager Dr. Gary Lysik has signed a Proclamation of a local emergency within the City to further proactively address the COVID-19 pandemic.

The goal of the proclamation, Lysik stressed, is not to create panic but instead to empower Calabasas to take additional legal, operational, and recovery measures that may be needed in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The proclamation, which is expected to be ratified by the Calabasas City Council later today, enhances the City's ability to access federal and state funds for COVID-19 response as well as receive services from Los Angeles County and other entities.

Calabasas continues to actively work to protect the health and safety of the community. City officials urge everyone to remain calm, and to continue to follow local, state, and federal directives associated with stopping the spread of COVID-19.
