City of Calabasas Executive Order #10

Los Angeles County Department of Public Health

Revised Order dated 6/18/2020

This weekend, the Los Angeles County Sherriff was called by neighbors due to a large gathering (party) which occurred in a private home within a gated community. The concern from neighbors was that such events were dangerous, and not permitted under Los Angeles County Department of Public Health orders.

The neighbors are correct to be concerned.

The Los Angeles County Order of June 18th, 2020 which the City has posted to its website (see below), continues to ban all "events and gatherings" under section 7. (i), and further requires the public to reduce transmission exposure through the use of facemasks, social distancing and frequent hand washing when interacting with anyone outside of a household.

Staff is monitoring Covid-19 cases within the City on a daily basis, and notes that unfortunately, cases continue to rise, and vigilance is still required to reverse this disturbing trend. As such, we ask for your assistance in informing your community of the law in place to protect everyone's safety.

I hope the above is of assistance to you all. Thanks again for your efforts to keep Calabasas safe.
