II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

Three residents of Mission Hills and Pacoima were arrested for possession of a stolen bicycle and burglary tools in the 4800 block of Las Virgenes Road. The subjects were contacted by deputies for a traffic violation. Two of the subjects were on probation and one had an arrest warrant. During the investigation, a bicycle was found in the suspect vehicle (black 2003 Honda Accord) and was determined to have been stolen from the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Police Department's Topanga Division. Numerous burglary tools were also found inside the vehicle. (20-03422)

A Northridge resident was arrested for possession of a stolen vehicle, narcotics and drug paraphernalia in the 4700 block of Park Granada. During the search of the vehicle which was stolen from the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Police Department's Foothill Division, stolen property taken from a theft from an unlocked vehicle in the 4700 block of Park Granada was found.
