II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A transient was arrested for residential burglary in the 23500 block of Park Belmonte. The suspect (victim's son) forced entry into the residence by damaging a door. The suspect was found hiding in a closet in an upstairs bedroom. (20-01482)

An Encino transient was arrested for residential burglary in the 23400 block of Park Hermosa. The suspect made entry via an unlocked rear door into the vacant home. Deputies had responded to the area regarding a trespassing and prowler call for service. The suspect had been seen going through backyards in the area. (20-01453)

Five arrests were made for theft of auto parts (catalytic converters) in the 26900 block of Deerweed Trail. The suspects (four males and one female) were from the Los Angeles area and were driving in a green 1997 Honda. The stolen catalytic converters were stolen from trucks in the Calabasas area. (20-01712)

Two grand theft incidents (stole cell phone in each incident) involving Uber drivers as victims occurred in the 23400 block of Park Sorrento and the 4200 block of Old Topanga Canyon. The suspects, two male blacks in their 20's, entered the victims vehicles and told the driver/victim that they wanted to change the location of drop off on the victim's phone. They then would grab/pry the cell phone from the victim's hand and would flee. A similar incident occurred at the Chevron gas station parking lot on Ventura Blvd in the unincorporated area of Calabasas involving a Lyft driver as the victim. (20-01505, 01620)

An arson was reported in the 3900 block of Poppyseed Place. Video surveillance showed a male White, 25 to 35 years of age, spray an unknown liquid onto the front door and then lit the door on fire with a torch lighter. The suspect fled on a motorized scooter. The victims were home at the time of the incident. (20-01890)
