SUMMARY INFORMATION:

The False Alarm Program was designed to protect lives and property. If properly installed, they are a real asset. If misused or not maintained, they become a liability, and spend a significant amount of money and wasted man hours.

The attached chart is a summary for the number of false alarms received by the Malibu/Lost Hills Sheriff's Department for the months of January – June 2020. Monthly total false alarms were January – 51; February – 59; March – 34; April – 19; May – 59, and June – 38.

Please review the attached False Alarm Report that shows yearly, quarterly and monthly totals for 2019 and 2020. Also included are the number of additional notices sent out as well as the breakdown of business false alarms vs. residential false alarms.
