Look Closer, What Do You See?

- Learn to notice more about common objects by drawing big – you'll be enlarging details of things around you!

Gather Your Supplies

- You'll need a **pen or pencil** for drawing; **crayon or marker** for coloring; and a **few sheets of blank paper**.

Warm-Up

- Let's get your hands moving! Spend a few minutes making a series of loose scribbles on your paper.

Let's Start!

- Pick a nearby object in your environment, like a book or food.
- Choose one part of it to focus on for your drawing – it could be because of an interesting pattern or texture that it has or something else that caught your interest.
- Start with basic shapes, like circles and squares, to draw your favorite part **BIG** to fill your page.
- Add any details to your drawing that you notice on the object.
- Add some color to the object – color around the edges of it to make it **JUMP** off the page!

What Did You Discover?

- What details did you notice about the object that you chose? Did you find anything new or surprising?
