II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A transient from out of state was arrested in the 26500 block of Agoura Road for possession of an unregistered firearm/a high capacity magazine/loaded firearm and having a concealed firearm in his vehicle (blue 2007 Honda Fit). The suspect was contacted by deputies during a patrol check of a shopping center at the location. The suspect was found slumped over the steering wheel with an open beer can between his legs and the suspect's associate, passenger in the vehicle, was sleeping in a reclined position. The suspect's associate was not charged with any crime. (20-03922)

A Simi Valley resident was arrested for carrying a loaded firearm in a vehicle (2016 Toyota Tacoma) in the area of the 101 Freeway and Las Virgenes Road. The suspect was contacted by deputies for a traffic violation. During the investigation, a loaded firearm was found inside the vehicle. The firearm belonged to the suspect's father. (20-04151)

A catalytic converter theft occurred in the 24700 block of Calabasas Road. Video surveillance showed three suspects (males) in three vehicles pull up to the bus yard and used power tools to cut the catalytic converters on seven city buses. The suspects' vehicles were a grey Honda sedan, a dark colored Ford F-150 and a white colored sedan. (20-04159)

Three vehicle burglaries and one theft from unlocked vehicle were reported during the same date and time frames. The incidents occurred in the 4000 and 4200 blocks of Towhee Drive and the 22700 blocks of Sparrow Dell Drive and Town Crier. Property stolen consisted of wallets, gift cards, hand tools, a camera/lenses/equipment and U.S. currency. All vehicles were parked in the driveway area. In one incident, two male suspects were confronted by the victim and fled in a blue Nissan Rogue. These same two suspects were captured on video surveillance using the victims' stolen credit cards at several gas stations and a 7-11 store along Ventura Blvd in Woodland Hills. II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A robbery occurred in the 26700 block of Agoura Road. Two subjects, residents of Northridge, were arrested for this incident. One subject entered the location, armed with a handgun and a hammer. The other subject was waiting in the getaway vehicle (white 2007 Toyota Yaris). The subject, inside the location, smashed a jewelry case and began to take watches. An employee tried to stop the suspect from taking the merchandise, but was fearful because of the handgun that the suspect was holding. Another employee was able to pin the suspect down on the ground until deputies arrived. (20-05001)

A Granada Hills resident was arrested for possession of a firearm/assault rifle and narcotics in the area of Las Virgenes Road and 101 Freeway. The subject was contacted by deputies for a traffic violation. During the investigation, narcotics and an AR-15 assault rifle were found inside the vehicle. (20-04646)

A theft occurred in the 23700 block of Calabasas Road. The suspect, female black adult, entered the location and placed store products (perfumes) in a shopping basket. The suspect then exited the location without paying for the store items. The investigation is on-going and this same suspect committed a similar incident in the jurisdiction of the Pasadena Police Department. (20-04695)

II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A Calabasas resident was arrested for attempt murder in the 24600 block of Park Miramar. The suspect stabbed the victim in the arm with a samurai sword for unknown reasons. He was also charged with resisting a peace officer, possession of drug paraphernalia and falsely identifying self to a peace officer. After finding the suspect's true identity, he had two warrants out of New Mexico for violation of probation conditions, transportation and possession of controlled substances/firearms/destruction device by a felon/drug paraphernalia, driving with a suspended license and evading/obstructing a peace officer. Two subjects, residents of Reseda and Van Nuys, were arrested for identity theft, possession of controlled substances/drug paraphernalia/burglary tools/stolen property and mail theft in the 4800 block of Las Virgenes Road.
