New Emergency Order dated 12/27/2020

We write to advise you of the extended and indefinite period for new Covid-19 Executive Orders in place as of December 27, 2020, as ordered by the Los Angeles County Public Health Officer due to the surge of cases in Los Angeles County. Calabasas is not immune to the virus; as of today, 668 cases of Covid-19 have been reported in the City, a disturbing 50% increase from 441 cases at the beginning of December.

It is against this backdrop that we again implore your HOA to be vigilant for any gathering or party taking place, especially New Year celebrations. In the past three weeks, numerous parties, some well into the hundreds, have occurred in defiance of the Health orders. City Code Enforcement Staff, in addition to the Los Angeles County's Lost Hills Sherriff's office, have responded and *will* take action to disperse the event. The order, which is found in the link below, continues to prohibit gatherings of any group of persons outside of a household; any gathering, either inside or outside, is prohibited.
