



# CPA Recently Added Three Power Purchase Agreements

## **Total of 352 Megawatts of Carbon-Free Energy**

- White Hills Wind Farm -- 300-Megawatt (MW) new-build wind farm, went into operation December 16, 2020.
- Golden Fields Solar – 40-Megawatt (MW) photovoltaic solar site, went into operation December 22, 2020; three months ahead of schedule.
- Isabella Small Hydro – a run-of-river small hydroelectric site, 11.95 Megawatts (MW).

# **CPA Green House Gas Emissions Impact**

**The estimated emission reductions CPA-wide for all products in FY 19/20 was just over 1 million MT CO<sub>2</sub>e.**

**This represents a 41% reduction from what CPA customers' net emissions would have been with SCE.**

**Or conversely, CPA customers' emissions were 59% of what they would have been with SCE.**

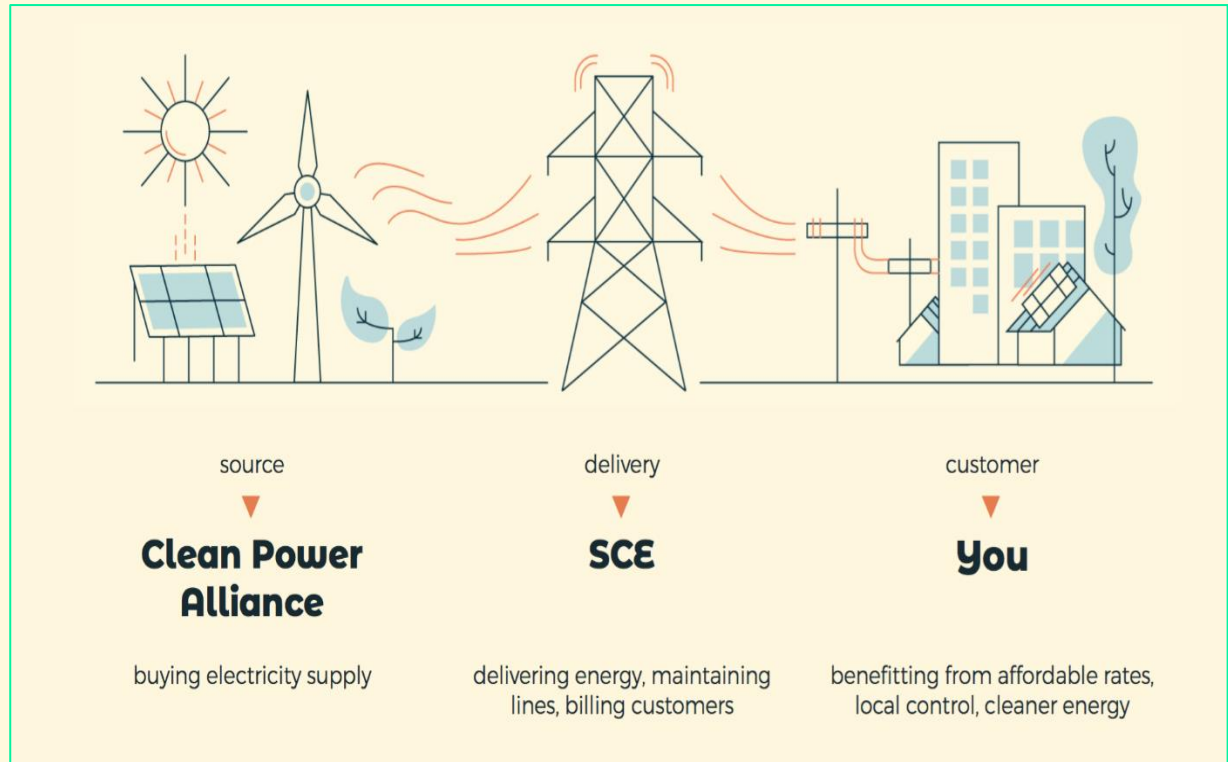

Clean Power Alliance purchases clean power and Southern California Edison (SCE) delivers it.

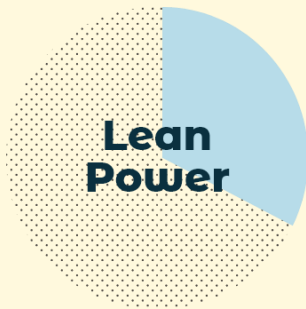

# Clean Power Alliance offers Choices

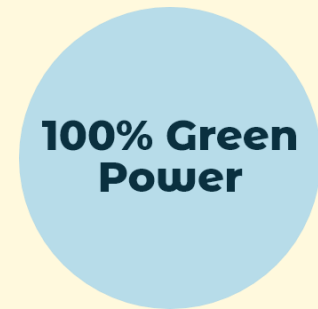
**Customers can choose between any of our three rate options at any time.**



**Lean Power** provides 36% renewable energy content at the lowest possible cost, with a 1-2% savings compared to SCE

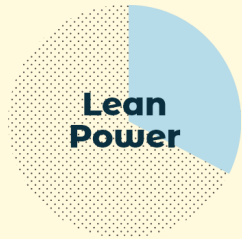


**Clean Power** provides 50% renewable energy content with a 0-1% bill savings compared to SCE



**100% Green Power** provides 100% renewable energy content with a 7-9% premium compared to SCE

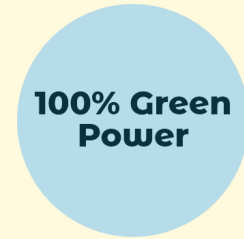

# Financial Assistance Programs & Resources





## Which Program Is Right For Me?



### California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) Program

*You participate in a public assistance program or meet income requirements*

The **CARE Program** reduces energy bills for eligible customers by about 30%.



### Family Electric Rate Assistance (FERA) Program

*You have a family of 3 or more, participate in a public assistance program or meet income requirements*

The **FERA Program** reduces energy bills for eligible customers by about 18%.



### Medical Baseline Program

*If you or someone in your household needs electrically powered medical equipment or meets income requirements*

The **Medical Baseline Program** supplies additional energy at no extra cost to your normal energy use to keep your devices going.

SCE administers each of these programs and CPA customers already enrolled in CARE/FERA/Medical Baseline before transitioning into CPA don't need to re-apply.
