SUBJECT: Discussion of ideas for celebrating Calabasas' 30th

Anniversary

RECOMMENDATION: Discuss ideas for celebrating Calabasas' 30th Anniversary

The City of Calabasas was incorporated on April 5, 1991. Accordingly, the City has now reached its 30th anniversary, and the HPC has been asked to brainstorm ideas for appropriate and enjoyable ways for members of the community to celebrate and honor the milestone.

Here are a couple of potential ideas for consideration and discussion by the HPC members:

- **Scavenger Hunt** Citizens could be invited to participate in a 'scavenger hunt', whereby the participants would be challenged to locate and identify a number of photographed structures and/or items (such as a number of historic sites, as well as other notable local landmarks).
- **Photo Contest** Citizens could be invited to submit photographs of the City's designated historic landmarks. Awards could be offered for best submittals (such as 'Best Color Photo' and 'Best Black & White')

However, it is entirely up to members of the Commission to conjure up their own ideas, and to consider these ideas as a group. Staff's suggestions are hardly the limit! Any proposals deemed suitable by a consensus of the group will be forwarded to the City Manager and the Mayor.
