SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

To approve the appointment of Anika Kolanu to the Parks, Recreation and Education Commission as a student member.

BACKGROUND:

The Parks, Recreation, and Education Commission regularly appoints one high school resident of Calabasas to provide input on community matters. The Student Member serves as a non-voting member of the Commission providing insight on the needs and priorities of local teens.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

Commission Chair, Laurel Ford and Facility Supervisor, Aimee Haber interviewed a number of qualified candidates in March, 2021, before recommending Anika Kolanu to the position. Having grown up in the LVUSD school system, she is currently serving as the leader of promotions on the Calabasas High School Associated Student Body. She is also an active member of the Mayor's Youth Council exploring both local and global issues and developing Citywide programs in response. Lastly, Anika provided the selection committee with innumerable insights from her own direct experience with Community Services programs, events and park facilities.
