- Overview of State and Calabasas Laws for Single Family Residential Neighborhoods:
 - Activities which require no permit
 - Activities which require a permit
 - Ministerial
 - Discretionary
 - Activities which are prohibited

- No Permit is required for a Garage Sale
 - Up to 4 times a year, max. three day duration
 - Resident sale of personal property



- No Permit is required to Rent your Home
 - Must be for more than 30 days
 - No more than two bedrooms or rooms



Home Rental Regulations

- "Tenants" vs "Guests" occupancy under 30 days
 - Considered a "Transient Occupancy"
 - Considered a Commercial Hotel Use not permitted in Single Family Residential Zones
 - Guests do not...
 Clean the House
 Take out the Trash
 Do Laundry
 Pay Utility Bills
 Maintain Premises



Home Rental Regulations

- Rental of <u>3 or more rooms</u> is considered to be a **Boarding House**
 - Examples include sororities and fraternities

Not permitted in Single Family Neighborhood

Zones



- A Permit is required for Home Filming
 - Maximum 14 days per year, up to 20 with Council and community support
 - Managed by Contract under the MediaDepartment



- A Permit is required for Hobby Farms
 - Limited Agricultural Use
 - HM, OS and RR Zones only
 - Sustainable BMP's



- A Permit is required for Home Occupations
 - Business is conducted by the home resident
 - Subordinate to the primary residential use
 - May not generate traffic or noise
 - NeighborhoodCompatible:
 - Art Studios
 - Home Offices
 - Minimal Visitors/ Employees



- A Permit is required Bed and Breakfast Inns
 - HM, RC, RR and REC Zones only
 - Must have a primary resident
 - Allowed Conditionally;CUP required
 - No kitchens in rooms
 - Meets all home standards



A Permit is required for Day Care Facilities

- Licensed through Ca. Department of Social Services
- Serves Children or Adults
- Property is occupiedby a full time resident
- Zoning Clearance permit
- Subject to occupancy limits




- A Permit is required for Residential Care Homes
 - Regulated by the State
 - Up to 6 residents
 - Commonly called"Board and Care"
 - Issued by ZoningClearance




- A Permit is required for Secondary Housing **Units** (Accessory Dwelling Unit or "ADU")
 - Recently de-regulated by the State
 - Up to 1,200 SF
 - No occupancy under 30 days
 - Issued by Zoning Clearance



- Transient Unit Occupancy home or room rentals (less than 30 days) are prohibited
 - Considered to be "Hotels"
 - Not permitted in single family residential zones



- Use of a home to conduct commercial retailing activities is prohibited
 - Events do not preserve the residential character of the neighborhood
 - Examples include:
 - "Estate Sales"
 - "Trunk" Sales



Commercial Retailing "Red-Flags"

- Truck Deliveries
- New Merchandise
- Packaged Items
- Bulk Products
- Not Household Goods
- Public Advertisement
- Repeated Sales
- Short Duration Event



- Commercial Event Home Rentals <u>are</u> prohibited
 - Typically vacant structures; no residential value
 - Examples include:
 - Corporate retreat
 - Dinners
 - Performances
 - Workshops



Dance or Party House event rentals are prohibited

- Social Media used for event advertisement/promotion
- Alcohol beverage service may occur w/o Calif. ABC license
- Neighbors disturbed by noise, multiple Sheriff responses
- Dangerous/illegal assemblies possible:

Unpermitted structures
Unpermitted/inspected
gas/plumbing electrical
installations
Inadequate Exiting



Event Home Rentals "Red-Flags:

- Vacant Structure, no one in residence
- Advertised to the Public
- Unusual Parking
- Delivery Trucks
- Backyard Tents
- Unusually LargeGroups
- Amplified Sound
