### **SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

Select Date for the Parks, Recreation and Education (PRE) Commissioners to tour the City of Calabasas Parks and Facilities with Staff

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Since the Woolsey Fire in November 2018 through to present, there have been changes to the City's parks and facilities. Touring the parks together as the (PRE) Commission with staff will provide a platform for discussion and brainstorming with regard to implementing adjustments if needed in our programming and in park use. Future possibilities may be considered.

#### **DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:**

A tour with the Parks, Recreation and Education Commissioners and Staff will afford the Commission an opportunity to evaluate all aspects in serving the community at the highest level. Staff will guide the Commissioners around each park and facility to indicate new additions or upgrades, large or small. Playgrounds at the parks will be assessed. Staff can point out where specifically the programs offered throughout the year take place, and this will give Staff an opportunity to reacquaint the Commissioners with the facility's use and operations.

- Juan Batista de Anza Park
- Tennis & Swim Center
- Wild Walnut Park
