If City elects to extend the Term, City shall notify Contractor in writing no later than nine (9) months prior to the end of the then existing Term. If City does not notify Contractor nine (9) months prior to the end of the then existing Term, the City shall waive its option to further extend the Term. Waste Management/GI Industries would like to request the above extension option March 1, 2023 through February 28, 2025 in lieu of the recently requested rate adjustment due 7/01/2020.
