II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A robbery was reported in the 5900 block of Las Virgenes Road. The victim's ex-boyfriend arrived at the location, forcibly took her cell phone as she attempted to dial 9-1-1 and fled. The suspect was also charged with domestic violence, prevent from calling 9-1-1 and violation of a restraining order. (21-02642)

The victim and his family had finished dinner in the 23600 block of Calabasas Road. They were walking to their vehicle when a vehicle (early 90's Toyota Corolla, white, no hubcaps) driven by a male Hispanic, 20 to 25 years of age, (suspect) drove by and parked. The victim stated the suspect exited his vehicle, pulled a handgun out of his pocket and pointed it at him while charging/running towards him. The victim in fear of getting shot entered his vehicle with his family and drove away. The suspect entered his vehicle and appeared to follow the victim but then continued eastbound onto Calabasas Road and out of view. (21-02549)

An Inglewood resident was arrested in the 3600 block of Beverly Blvd, Los Angeles for possession of stolen property by the Los Angeles Police Department. The second suspect was able to elude capture. The stolen property (luggage, bags, tool box, purse, laptop, iPad and clothing) were found in the vehicle that the suspect was driving. The vehicle was reported stolen from the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Police Department's Olympic Division. The stolen property was taken from an incident of theft from an unlocked vehicle that occurred in the 4600 block of Park Granada. The suspects are possibly responsible for committing a commercial burglary in the 23600 block of Calabasas Road. (21-02649, 02776)

An arson was reported in the 4200 block of Lost Hills Road. An unknown suspect set fire to the greenbelt behind the condominium complex. (21-02778)

A resident of Lancaster was arrested for mail theft in the 6000 block of Las Virgenes Road. A call was received regarding a vehicle (black Acura sedan) parked in the middle of the street and causing a traffic hazard. The suspect was contacted and found to be on active probation for vandalism. During the search of the suspect's vehicle, mail and driver's license/identification cards and debit/store charge cards not in the name of the suspect were found inside. (21-02657).
