### **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS REPORT**

This report will now include a summary of the False Alarm Report.

**Discussions with the City Manager** – emergency preparedness topics that were discussed with each of the commissioners. Topics discussed were outreach, partnerships, utilizing CERP and PSC, EOP, Crime Prevention seminar, increasing security, Appreciation Luncheon, Flock camera system, wildfire preparedness & evacuations, brush clearance, Neighborhood Watch, community hero, decentralization of emergency preparedness, homelessness and ransomware attacks.



**Crime Prevention** – need to form a subcommittee. Assign 2 commissioners to work with staff to prepare for a workshop/seminar/expo/fair.

**Emergency Preparedness Activities** – The Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness department will be attending all major city events with a booth setup and handouts/swag. Norma Citron volunteered at the first Summer Concert in the Park. The next concert is scheduled for Sunday August 8 at 6:00 pm.

**Ham Radio Licensing Class** - Norm Goodkin is not planning any classes for the rest of the year due to decreased interest, and will resume next year. There were 7 signed up for the April class - only 3 of those attended and they all passed.

**CERP Radio Net** - Calabasas Emergency Radio Program. The regularly scheduled radio net is running smoothly on Wednesday's at 8:00 am.

**CERT** - Community Emergency Response Training. Staff is working with the Fire Department to schedule dates for the final CERT drill that was cancelled last year due to Covid and also schedule a new CERT class.

**False Alarm Program** – The 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter false alarm statistics were similar to the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter statistics. Both quarters had about 120 false alarms for 3 months.

**CPR Training**

An adult/child/infant/AED and First Aid class was held for employees and volunteers of the city on July 14, 2021 through the American Heart Association.
