II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A robbery was reported in the 23700 block of Calabasas Road. The suspects entered the business, walked to the fragrance isle, removed trash bags from underneath their clothing and proceeded to fill the trash bags with perfumes. One perfume fell on the floor and the employee bent down to recover it. The female suspect put her nails on the employee's hand and scared the employee. The suspects, a female and male, wearing all black, fled the location with the stolen property in a blue Honda Accord. The suspects had committed a similar incident earlier in the city of Santa Clarita. The suspects' vehicle was located by the California Highway Patrol and the suspects were arrested with the stolen property in the Merced area. (21-04255)

A "home invasion" robbery occurred in the 5300 block of Las Virgenes Road. The victim placed an ad on Craigslist advertising the adoption of Maltipoo puppies. An unknown person contacted the victim via text message and agreed to purchase the puppy. Two suspects arrived at the victim's residence on Las Virgenes Road. They told the victim they wanted to buy two puppies. Then they pushed the victim out of the way and entered her residence. Once inside, the male suspect grabbed a puppy and ran out of the home. The female suspect grabbed another puppy, however, the victim was able to pull the dog away from the female suspect. The suspects were described as a White male and White female in their 30's. A resident was arrested for assault in the 22800 block of Mulholland Highway. The suspect, a tenant at the victim's residence, began to argue with the victim about rent owed. The suspect assaulted the victim by punching him in his face. The victim was transported to a nearby hospital for his injuries. (21-03767)

Two burglaries of detached residential garages were reported in the 4200 block of Las Virgenes Road during the same date and time frames. Both garages were unlocked. In one incident, suspect(s) unknown made entry into the unlocked vehicle parked inside the garage. LOST HILLS JUVENILE INTERVENTION UNIT ACTIVITY REPORT FOR JULY 2021 CALABASAS

A. SCHOOL ISSUES

House checks re: SARB/attendance issues Assisted Round Meadow Elementary re info.

B. INTERVENTIONS

Counseled parents and juveniles re: incidents at parks, schools, and miscellaneous areas within our jurisdiction.

C. COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES

- 1. We conducted a monthly parental resource class at Lost Hills Sheriff's Station. This program was developed by our unit and is designed to educate parents about: 1) The current trends in juvenile behavior and delinquency, 2) Alcohol/narcotic awareness and recognition, 3) School policy and campus issues, 4) Gangawareness and negative peer relations, 5) Parental rights and responsibilities and, 6) Parental responses to incorrigible and/or delinquent behavior. We also address the specific concerns relating to the minor's behavior. We educate the minor and their parents of possible criminal behavior and the legal consequences. We offer suggestions and make recommendations to improve the minor's quality of life.
- 2. Spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question various juvenile concerns and issues in the community. We also provide the parents with various juvenile resource programs within our community.
- 3. We met with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- 4. Met with Captain Salvador Becerra throughout the month in order to keep him up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within our city.
- 5. Entered juveniles into the Juvenile Automated Index system for various violations.
- 6. Made court appearances to testify as witnesses on the part of the People of the State of California and attended court proceedings in cases generated from the City of Calabasas. We also investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. We additionally assisted other investigators in the preparation of cases for court.
- 7. Met with station narcotic detectives on a regular basis to exchange information regarding juvenile and drug related issues. We have worked with the narcotic detectives on several narcotic cases directly and indirectly involving juveniles.
- 8. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit (i.e., Juvenile Information Forms, Field Interview Cards, Juvenile Automated Index, and citations for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel).
- 9. Conducted our normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile related calls for service.

- 10. Updated the Gang Book and briefed the captain on criminal activity trends.
- 11. Registered 4 sexual predators and updated information in database.
- 12. eSCARS system updated.
- 13. Month End Reports completed.
- 14. Assisted Records Sealing Unit with several cases.
- 15. Uniform store re: station needs.
- 16. PDC/Wayside re: Tactics and Survival Training
- 17. Assisted Patrol re: CARP, backfill behind patrol/shortage, COVID-19, Safe Canyons, The Oaks, mandatory overtime.
