Rondell Smart Park Ribbon-Cutting to be Held Friday August, 27, 2021

The City will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the new Rondell Smart Park facility on Friday, August 27th at 9 a.m. on Rondell Road, east of Las Virgenes Road, just south of the 101 freeway. The public is invited to attend. The Smart Park is adjacent to the Rondell Oasis Hotel, which is presently in the final stages of construction.

The Rondell Smart Park Project was built to provide a convenient and muchneeded parking facility to serve Las Virgenes corridor ride-share commuters, transit users, and people using trails around Juan de Anza Park.

The newly completed parking lot features 131 parking spaces, 5 of which will be dedicated for trailhead parking, 15 for transit users, and 4 for electric vehicle charging stations. The City will monitor usage of the lot every 3 months and adjust dedicated spaces as needed.

"The new Rondell Smart Park facility will provide area residents and visitors with a safe, convenient location to park their vehicles, while also making alternative forms of transportation more readily available," said Calabasas Mayor James R. Bozajian.

The Smart Park project was possible due to Measure R and M Local Return Funds.
