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II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A Mission Hills resident was arrested for robbery, residential burglary, child endangerment and criminal threats in the 3900 block of Ceanothus Place. The suspect made entry into his estranged wife's residence without permission. The suspect then threatened his teenage daughter with bodily harm if she refused to give him money. (21-04773)

Five residential burglaries were reported in the Calabasas Park neighborhood area. The locations of the incidents were the 4200 block of Park Alisal, the 4300 blocks of Park Corona and Park Vicente, 23100 block of Park Contessa and the 23200 block of Park Ensenada. In two incidents, there were no signs of forced entry into the locations. The front door glass windows were smashed to gain entry into two residences and the other residence had its bedroom window smashed. Property stolen consisted of firearms, savings bonds, a fire box and jewelry. (21-04823, 04877, 05130, 05188, 05195)

A resident of Canoga Park was arrested for possession of a stolen vehicle in the area of Agoura Road and Las Virgenes Road. The vehicle was stolen from the jurisdiction of the Burbank Police Department. The suspect was also charged with vehicle tampering and possession of stolen property (stolen vehicle license plates from the Canoga Park area). (21-04780)

Six thefts from unlocked vehicles were reported in the neighborhoods of Avalon Calabasas (3800 block Orchid Lane), Deer Springs (3800 block Cottonwood Grove Trail), Lone Oak (26600 blocks of Goldenrod Place and Marigold Court) and Stone Creek (4300 block Willow Glen Street) during the same day and time frames. Property stolen consisted of iPod, earbuds, keys, prescription medication, credit cards, a wallet, sunglasses, a garage remote control, U.S. currency, a wet suit and a suitcase with clothing. In one incident (3800 block Cottonwood Grove), video surveillance showed the suspect as male adult, wearing a dark colored shirt, light colored jeans and was in a white or silver Chevrolet Tahoe, 2007 to 2014 year model, with possible traffic collision damage on driver's side front bumper.
