RECOMMENDATION: Discuss Goals for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 CLG Report

REVIEW AUTHORITY:

All matters regarding historic resource identification and designation, resource preservation policies and standards, and project reviews where such projects may affect a designated or eligible resource, fall to the Historic Preservation Commission (ref. CMC Chapters 2.30 and 17.38). Furthermore, the City of Calabasas, through the HPC, functions as a Certified Local Government (CLG) under California historic preservation law. Accordingly, the HPC will review and discuss potential goals for inclusion in the upcoming CLG annual report.

BACKGROUND:

One of the requirements of the CLG program is submittal of an annual report to the California State Historic Preservation Office (SHiPO). The reporting period conforms to the Federal fiscal year, which is October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022. The SHiPO requires the City to address forecasted preservation goals within the annual report for the 2021 – 2022 fiscal year.

At the meeting staff will lead the Commission members in a discussion of possible FY 2021 – 2022 goals.
