Woolsey Fire Contributions

- November 8, 2018
- 1,643 structures destroyed total
- Calabasas
 - 6 structures damaged or destroyed
 - 9 single-family homes destroyed
- Brandon aided LA County Firefighters in in protecting the Saratoga Hills neighborhood.
 - Monitored hotspots
 - Turned on landscape irrigation sprinklers
 - Assisted fire crews with laying hoses, chasing down embers
