STRATEGIC PLANNING

Definition

A disciplined effort to produce fundamental decisions and actions that shape and guide what an agency is, what it does, and why.

<u>Steps</u>

- 1. Develop a clear understanding of the agency's mission and vision
- 2. Formulate key strategies that are essential to the agency's success
- 3. Identify agency goals and objectives that allow us to achieve our vision
- 4. Create an plan for implementation, resource requirements, and performance measurement

Result

Development of a strategic plan, which serves as a blueprint for how the City will achieve its mission and vision – a bridging of the gap.

BENEFITS & EXPECTATIONS

Benefits

- Adaptable: Balances short and long term operational objectives against constantly changing environment
- <u>Increases operational efficiency and effectiveness</u>: Prioritizes operations with defined goals, financial parameters, and performance measurement
- <u>Participatory and communicative</u>: Staff, residents, and Council involved, and so expectations are clearly aligned for all stakeholders

- "To maintain the community characteristics and quality of life that make Calabasas a desirable place for our residents and businesses."

<u>Vision</u>

- Describing the City in the future how will we achieve our mission?
- "Calabasas will preserve both its character and natural resources, and will lead on addressing the critical environmental, social, health, safety, and economic issues that impact our community."

WORKSHOP

Goal: Refine the Draft Projects & Initiatives List (attached to staff report)

City Council to designate no more than 5 projects per Strategic Priority category, or 30 projects in total

Considerations

- Staff is seeking project and initiative recommendations that are:
 - Significant, and that fall outside of day-to-day operations
 - Specific and measurable
 - Can be achieved within the 2022-23 fiscal year time frame
- City Council may add additional projects not listed in the draft list
