- a. National Register

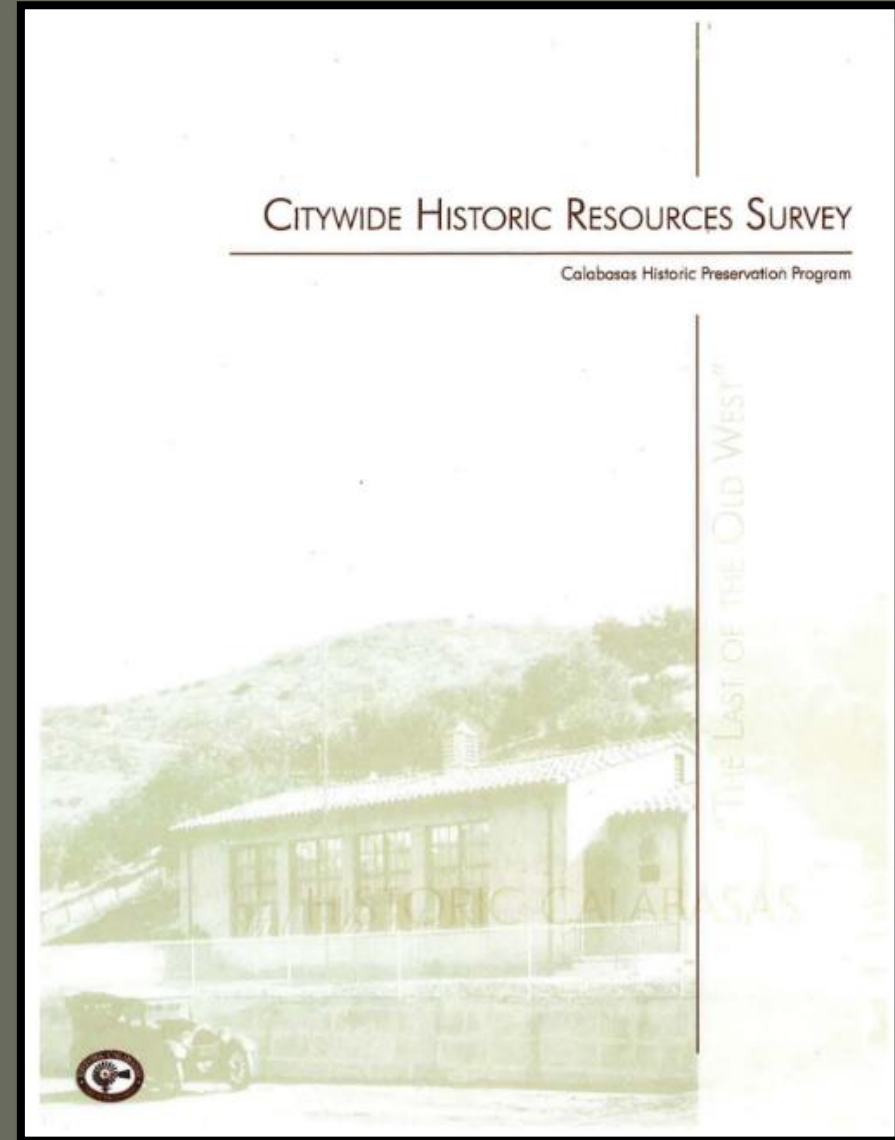
2) State Programs

- c. California Point of Historical Interest

3) Local Programs

- a. Calabasas Historic Landmarks

What makes a property (resource) eligible?

Historic resource surveys are performed to identify, record and evaluate historic properties within an area. A Historic Resource can be a district, building, site, structure or object that:

- Exemplifies a period of history
- Is associated with significant historical events
- Is associated with the lives of persons significant to Calabasas in the past
- Embody a particular architectural style, type or method of construction (High artistic values)
- Yields information important to history or prehistory within the area.

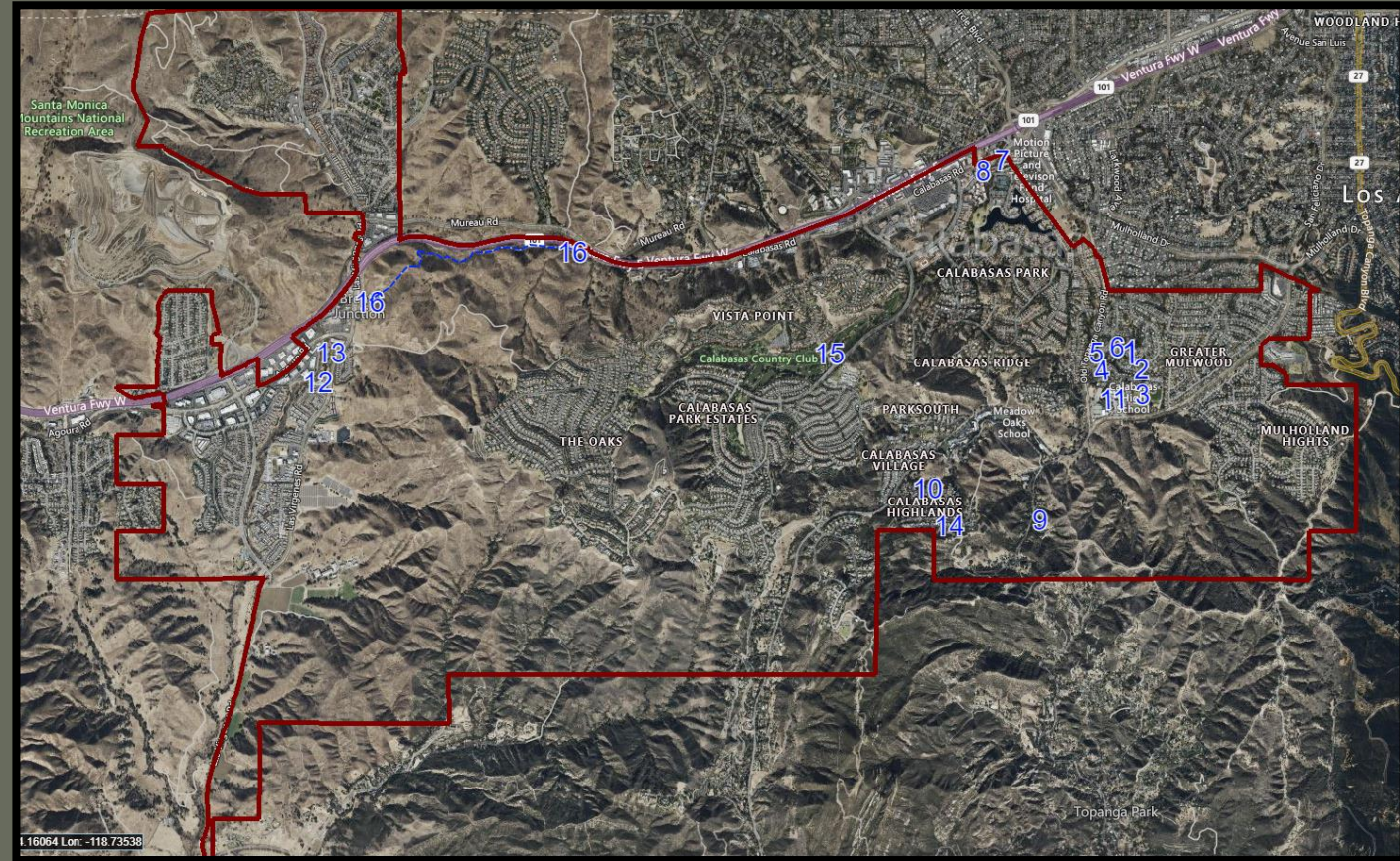

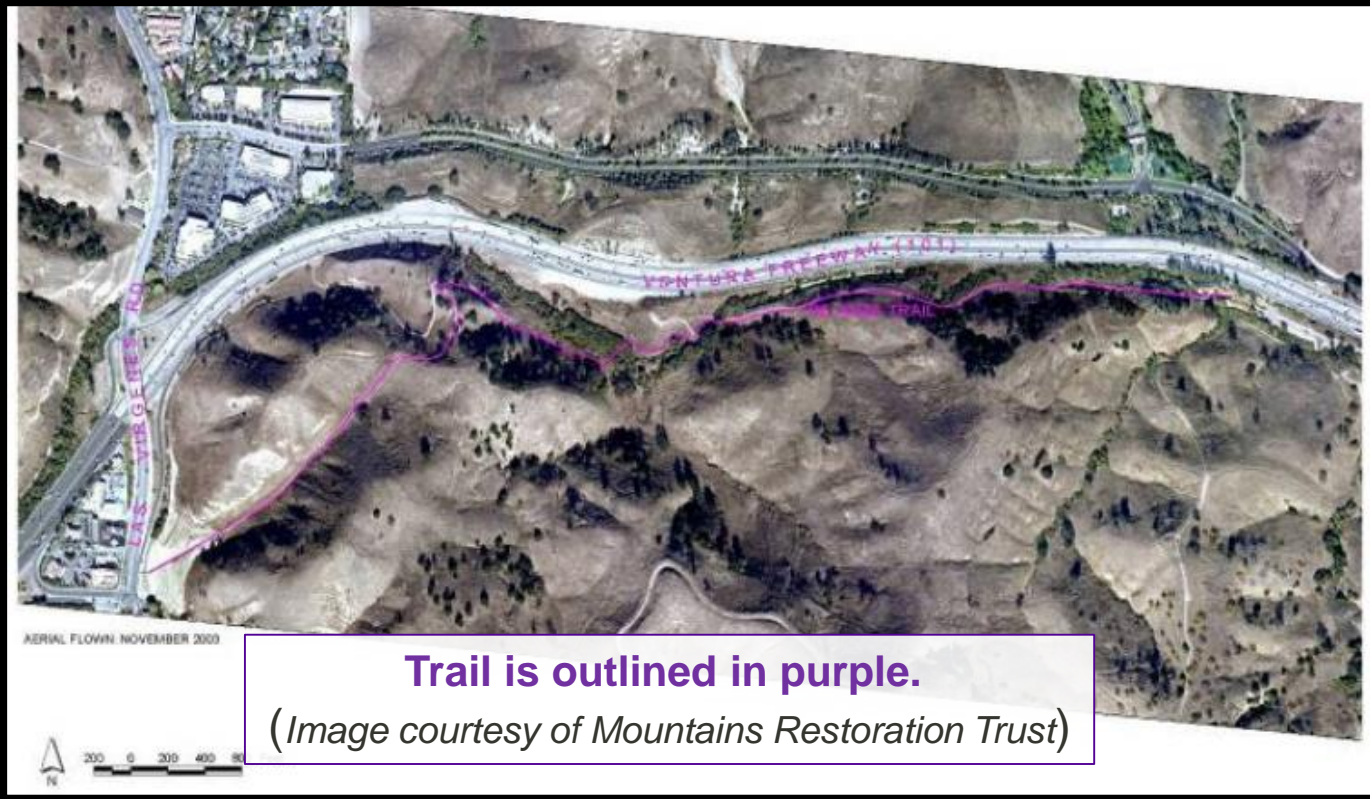

Historic Resources - Resurvey

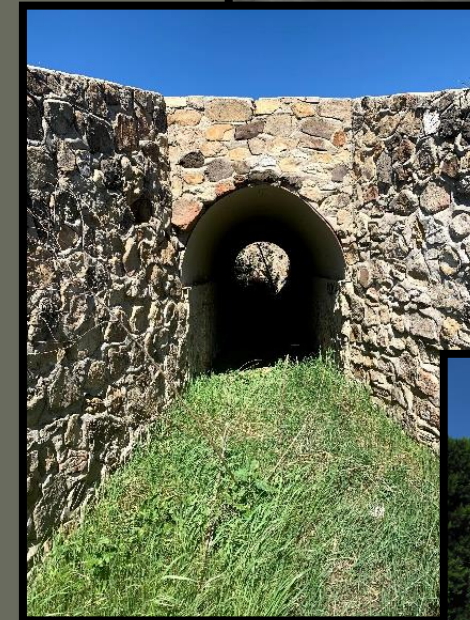
If surveyed (or re-surveyed), and the survey would so conclude, the following properties and structures have the potential to be eligible:

Structures to Survey:

- Dry Canyon Cold Creek Rd– Cattle Crossing

Properties to Re-survey:

- 4500 Park Granada – Lockheed Headquarters (1986)
 - Reevaluation at 45 years of age
- 23820 Mulholland Hwy – Geodesic Dome Residence (1989)
 - Reevaluation at 45 years of age
