Project Description

- The project proposal is a request for a Conditional Use Permit to allow for a new clothing retail tenant, MSFTS Rep, located at 23504 Calabasas Rd Ste 3 & 4 within the Calabasas Old Town (CT) zoning district.
- Calabasas Municipal Code (CMC) Section 17.62.060 requires Conditional Use Permit requests to be reviewed by the Planning Commission.
- Calabasas Municipal Code (CMC) Section 17.11.010(F) stipulates that a retail clothing store shall be allowed in the CT zoning district via CUP, only where in compliance with the Old Town Master Plan.





Site Plan






Existing Floor Plan






Proposed Floor Plan






Retail Sales

- City's Land Use Table stipulates that a retail clothing store shall be allowed in the CT zoning district via a CUP, only where in compliance with the Old Town Master Plan. The Master Plan encourages ground-floor retail on this parcel.
- MSFTS is a retail clothing company specializing in high-quality clothing made from resourceful and bio-based materials.
- The proposed hours of operation will be 10am-7pm Monday-Saturday, and 11am-7pm Sunday. 3 employees are anticipated on-site during store hours.

Findings

Conditional Use Permit

- The proposed use is conditionally permitted within the subject zoning district and complies with all of the applicable provisions of this development code;
- The proposed use is consistent with the General Plan and any applicable specific plan or master plan;
- The approval of the conditional use permit for the proposed use is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and
- The location and operating characteristics of the proposed use are compatible with the existing and anticipated future land uses in the vicinity.



Staff Conclusions

- The proposed retail clothing & accessory shop is a <u>conditionally</u> <u>permitted use</u> in the CT zoning district.
- The project is exempt from CEQA review.
- The proposed project <u>meets all required findings</u> for a <u>Conditional</u> <u>Use Permit.</u>

Recommended Action

That the Commission adopt Resolution No. 2022-739, approving File No. CUP-2022-003.
