II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A Monrovia resident was arrested for robbery in the 26700 block of Agoura Road. The suspect entered the location and was seen by an employee exiting the location without paying for the items (alcoholic beverage and food Items). The employee/victim asked for the stolen items back and the suspect assaulted the victim. (21-06174)

A resident was arrested for four robberies that occurred in the 5200 block of Las Virgenes Road, the 26300 block of Plata Lane and two similar robbery incidents in the city of Agoura Hills. The victims were employed by different marijuana dispensary businesses and were robbed by the suspect when they were making deliveries to him. (21-06280, 06309)

A felony domestic violence incident was reported in the 26300 block of Thousand Oaks Blvd. The suspect was arrested for assaulting his girlfriend during an argument. (21-06498)

A resident was arrested for commercial burglary in the 26700 block of Malibu Hills Road. The suspect entered the front gate of the apartment complex which was unlocked and jumped over the second gate. The suspect then entered the unlocked lounge area of the complex. The stolen property was recovered. (21-05924)

A commercial burglary occurred in the 26700 block of Agoura Road. The front glass door was smashed to gain entry. Video surveillance showed two male adults making entry using a glass breaking device. No property was stolen from the location. A similar incident occurred in the city of Westlake Village with same date/time frames and method of entry and a safe was stolen from this location. Three subjects, residents of Palmdale, Panorama City and Sylmar, were arrested for catalytic converter theft, possession of burglary tools and counterfeit money in the area of Las Virgenes Road and Mureau Road. The stolen catalytic converter was taken from a 2011 Toyota Prius in the 5900 block of Las Virgenes Road. The suspects were driving a grey 2006 Lincoln Zephyr when contacted by deputies. There were ten additional incidents of catalytic converter theft reported this month in the 4700 block of Park Granada, 4900 block of Las Virgenes Road, 5300 block of Parkmor Road, 23400 and 23900 blocks of Park Sorrento, 23500 block of Calabasas Road, 26100 block of Alizia Canyon and the 26700 block of Agoura Road. There is no suspect(s) description on these incidents. Targeted vehicles were 2004 Honda Accord, 2009 Honda CRV, 2006/2007/2008 Toyota Prius', 2005 Toyota Tundra pickup, 2016/2019 Ford F550 bus, 2004 Chevrolet Suburban and 1999 Ford E350 van. An arson of a stolen vehicle was reported in the 24400 block of Mulholland Highway. The vehicle was stolen from the jurisdiction of the Los Angeles Police Department. No suspect(s) seen or heard. (21-06218)
