

Architectural Review Panel Selection

Architectural Review Panel Timeline

- In accordance with the CMC, on October 30, 2021, the two year term expired for all Architectural Review Panel (ARP) members.
- Members may continue to serve on the ARP until such time that a successor is appointed.
- The City Clerk notified each Panel member that their term had expired, and advertised on the City website that applications are open to serve on the ARP. At this time, Ken Stockton, chose not to continue to serve, creating a vacancy on the Panel.
- The application period for ARP was open from November 2021 to February 2022. The City Clerk received six total applications to serve on the ARP, four of which are for re-appointment of current members.



Architectural Review Panel Timeline

- On April 7, 2022, the Planning Commission interviewed the two applicants who had not yet served on the ARP.
- The four applicants for re-appointment were also in attendance and ready to address the Commission.
- Because all five positions had expired on October 30, 2021, the purpose of the April 7 meeting was for the Commission to appoint all five positions.
- However, due to miscommunication and technical difficulties that evening, the Commission was presented with the option to fill only one position, and to choose from the two new applicants.
- The Commission chose Mr. Dabach, who will serve until October 2023.



Tonight's Action

- Appoint the remaining four members to serve on the ARP, through October 2023.
- Consideration should be given to the remaining five applicants that filed an application with the Clerk to serve on the ARP.
- After all five appointments have been made, the Commission must then decide who will serve as a regular member of the ARP and who will serve as an alternate member. The Panel is made up of three regular members and two alternates.

Recommended Action

 That the Planning Commission appoint four members to the ARP and select three regular members and two alternates.
