3. Congressman Ted Lieu Virtual Youth Town Hall, Monday, May 9, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.; and discussion of topics to be addressed at this Town Hall

Mayor Maurer announced that Congressman Ted Lieu's Virtual Youth Town Hall will be held on Monday, May 9, 2022, via Facebook Live from 5-6:30 pm. Mayor Maurer stated that instead of the May 9 MYC meeting, Board members would attend Congressman Lieu's Town Hall meeting. Councilmember Bozajian provided information about the recent redistricting process and change in Congressional Districts. Board members were requested to submit a question for Congressman Lieu's Youth Town Hall.

#### 4. Reports from subcommittee leaders and discussion of upcoming events

- Civic Engagement: Chloe Elie reported that voter registration drives are planned on weekends through next month. They would like to hold a voter registration drive at the Calabasas Earth Day festival. Young Voter Night will take place on May 19, at 7 pm, at Founders Hall. The use of social media accounts for Calabasas and Viewpoint high schools to spread the word of these events was also discussed.
- Communications: Jordan Matalon suggested creating advertisements to promote the MYC Instagram account. The subcommittee started creating a flyer as promotion to encourage more people to follow Instagram. The subcommittee plans on posting upcoming events and narrowing down which residents are best to target.
- Cultural Awareness & Diversity: Ahana Bajaj discussed creating pamphlets for diversity months and spreading the pamphlets on social media. Mayor Maurer suggested using the subcommittee's funds to add books to the Library. The subcommittee will share their calendar to the Communications subcommittee.
- Environment: Sydney Improta encouraged members to attend the Earth Day event and spread the word on social media.
- Wellness: Nicole Mazaheri suggested partnering with the organization NAMI to host an event during Mental Health Awareness Month in May. The event would be a virtual presentation on Ending the Silence to help community members learn about the warning signs of mental health conditions. Nicole will notify Mayor Maurer and Ms. Hernandez about the exact date and time.
