#### **SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2022-1791 recognizing July as "Parks Make Life Better Month" in the City of Calabasas.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The California Parks and Recreation Society (CPRS) has designated the month of July as Parks Make Life Better Month. Recreation facilities and parks across the state annually use July to celebrate the kick-off of summer programming as well as a time to pull their communities together to volunteer, get involved in great outdoor physical activities and advocate for parks and recreation.

As we observe Parks Make Life Better Month, we recognize the vital contributions of employees and volunteers who assist public parks and recreation facilities. These dedicated people keep public parks clean and safe for visitors, organize and coach youth sports teams, provide special events, day camps, swim lessons, educational programming on health, nutrition and first aid, advocate for more open space and better trails, and fundraise for local improvements. They

ensure that public parks and recreation facilities are safe and accessible places for all citizens to enjoy.

CPRS is an organization dedicated to advancing park, recreation and conservation efforts that enhance quality of life for all people. Through a network of more than 6,000 recreation and park professionals and citizens, CPRS encourages the promotion of healthy lifestyles, recreation initiatives, and conservation of natural and cultural resources.
