SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Parks, Recreation and Education Commission receive and file this project update.

BACKGROUND:

In April of 2019, the City Council approved the Wild Walnut Master Plan; which included a dog park, play area, parking lot and portable restrooms. In June of 2020, City Council rejected all bids related to the project and gave direction to install a temporary dog park, value engineer the Wild Walnut Master Plan and determine other funding sources for a permanent park. In August 2020 installation of the temporary dog park began and opened in September of 2020.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

Per Council's direction staff worked with the original Master Plan Landscape Architect to value engineer the project. Staff received revised value engineered plans for the park this month and will be seeking public input on the project in the next month.

FISCAL IMPACT/SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Staff has applied for grant funding through the LA County Regional Park and Open Space District and will be seeking Council approval in August for other funding sources.
