#### II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A resident was arrested for felony domestic violence in the 4400 block of Paxton Place. The suspect assaulted his girlfriend during an argument. (22-03383)

The suspect, a Calabasas resident, was arrested for assault in the 26000 block of Redbluff Drive. The suspect assaulted his elderly parents during an argument. The suspect was also charged with elder assault. (22-02881)

Two incidents of theft of catalytic converters and two incidents of attempt theft of catalytic converters were reported this month. The attempt thefts occurred in the 3800 block of Poppyseed and the area of Las Virgenes and Parkmor Road. The vehicles targeted were a 2003 Toyota Prius and a 2005 Toyota Sequoia. In the incident that occurred on Poppyseed, the suspects were described as two males in a gray 4 door vehicle. The suspects that committed the incident in the area of Las Virgenes and Parkmor were described as a male and female in a white Toyota. The other two incidents occurred the 23800 block of Calabasas Road and the 27000 block of Helmond Drive. The vehicles targeted were a 2007 Honda Accord and a 2007 Toyota Prius. In the incident that was reported in the 23800 block of Calabasas Road, the suspects were two males in a silver vehicle. (22-03116, 03122, 03128, 03215)
