### SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2022-1809, authorizing the submittal of an application to CalRecycle to receive funding for the Used Oil Payment Program for the next five years.

### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:**

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) administers a program to provide opportunities for local governments to receive payments for used oil and oil filter collection/recycling programs. This payment program is not competitive and does not require local matching funds.

The City's used oil collection program is operated by the City's franchised hauler, Waste Management, and is held on the second Saturday of every alternate month.

#### FISCAL IMPACT/SOURCE OF FUNDING:

There is no fiscal impact associated with the adoption of this resolution.
