**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR
CALABASAS RESIDENTS EXPERIENCING FINANCIAL HARDSHIP**

The Rotary Club of Calabasas Charitable Foundation has the following three financial aid Grant programs available for residents:

Outreach Grant: Grant of up to \$500 -- Examples are but not limited to: Lack of funds for groceries; clothing needs; minor medical expenses/equipment needs; bus/train pass funding; education needs (such as books); minor vehicle repair expenses (such as tire replacement). Online application available.

Emergency Grant: Variable Grants of up to \$2,500 based on need. A one-time disbursement intended larger needs, such as: behind on rent facing eviction; major medical bills; disconnection of utilities; need for major car repairs to commute to work; lack of funds for groceries; clothing needs. Online application available, and a short follow-up interview is required.


Support Grant: Variable Grants of up to \$3000 based on need. Monthly disbursements for up to 6 months based on smaller needs, such as inadequate income to cover: Rent; medical prescriptions; disconnection of utilities; food and clothing needs; childcare expenses. Online application available, and a short follow-up interview is required.


NOTE: Grants are available from July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023 or until funding remains available. Some applicants may not qualify, and not all Grants applications are approved.

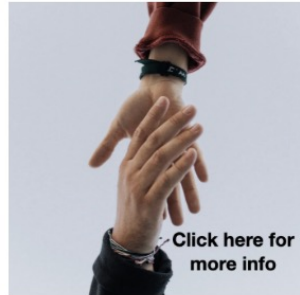


Financial Assistance Grants

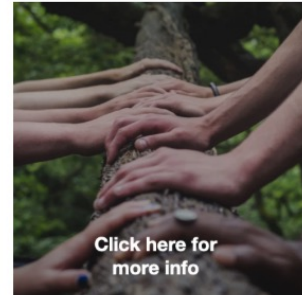

Outreach Grant

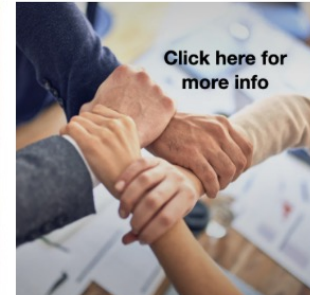
The Outreach Grant Program provides immediate financial help on a smaller grant scale (limited to a maximum of \$500.00) when an issue arises.
