Chair Mia Spiegel called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. via Zoom Teleconferencing.

**OPENING MATTERS**

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mia Spiegel.

**ORAL COMMUNICATION - PUBLIC COMMENT**

No one spoke during public comment.

**WELCOME/INTRODUCTIONS**

1. Welcome by Mayor Maurer

Mayor Maurer reported that campaigning for the November 8 General Election will be starting soon, and that she will not be seeking re-election. She named the candidates for Calabasas City Council: Edward Albrecht, James Bozajian Brian Cameron, Monica Parmar and David Shapiro.

2. Approval of meeting minutes from June 13 and August 8, 2022

## NEW BUSINESS

### 3. Group discussion and selection of Mayor's Youth Council logo

MYC members had a preference for the student-created logos. Logo number 2 received the most votes from MYC members and was selected as the MYC logo.

### 4. Discussion on what items to purchase with logo

Suggestions were made to print the logos on tablecloths, water bottles, and banners. Siena Goldfarb suggested creating shirts with the logo to wear at events. Noah Shapiro suggested creating hoodies with the logos. Wristbands and/or bracelets were also suggested to be distributed at the upcoming Pumpkin Festival.

### 5. Student Election Worker opportunities

Ms. Hernandez presented information and video regarding student election workers. Mrs. Hernandez stated that there will be two vote centers in Calabasas during the November 8 General Municipal Election. In addition, the City is working on getting two four-hour Flex Vote Centers.

### 6. Reports from subcommittee leaders and discussion of upcoming events

- Civic Engagement: Chloe Elie mentioned that Young Voter Night will be on September 20. She also stated that there will be another voter registration booth at the upcoming Pumpkin Festival.
- Communications: Jordan Matalon explained that the subcommittee is still waiting on a response on whether the Mayor's Youth Council Instagram page can purchase ads. The Instagram account will be posting flyers for upcoming events. A suggestion was also made to create a TikTok account for the Mayor's Youth Council.
- Cultural Awareness & Diversity: Ahana Bajaj would like to work on a diversity calendar to put up in libraries and local schools. Mia Spiegel suggested having an arts and craft table at the Pumpkin Festival for Indigenous Peoples Day. Councilmember Bozajian suggested having a conversation with the tribal advisory for future events.
- Environment: Niccolo Terrango said that a response is pending for the *Gasland* documentary screening. Mayor Maurer will watch the documentary and get back to the subcommittee to schedule a date for the screening.

- Wellness: Nicole Mazaheri spoke on promoting the National Mindfulness Day clothing drive that will be occurring on September 17 in front of the Calabasas Library.
