## II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A transient was arrested for assault in the 4700 block of Commons Way. The suspect was causing a business disturbance in the area and told to leave the location. He was refusing and the suspect then assaulted a LASD Sergeant during the arrest. (22-06197)

A residential burglary occurred in the 24100 block of Park Granada. A bathroom window was smashed to gain entry. Property stolen consisted of a jewelry box with jewelry, U.S. currency, purses, and watches. Video footage showed two males, adults in dark clothing and wearing gloves. (22-80040)

Two incidents of theft were reported in the 22200 block of Mulholland Highway. In one incident, two suspects, male Hispanics, one between 25 to 30 years and the other between 40 to 50 years, wearing face masks entered the location, selected wine bottles and stuffed them inside their jackets. They fled in a grey, mid 2000's Mercedes Benz M-Class SUV. In the other incident, two suspects, female adults, entered the location, selected multiple bottles of alcohol and placed them into a large personal bag one suspect was carrying. They fled the location without paying for the items. No vehicle seen. (22-06390, 06602)
