**OPENING MATTERS**

**ORAL COMMUNICATION - PUBLIC COMMENT**

No one spoke during public comment.

**WELCOME/INTRODUCTIONS**

1. Welcome by Mayor Maurer and follow up information regarding Fentanyl

Mayor Maurer reported that the City Council adopted a Resolution that condemns the government of Iran for the physical beatings and deaths of multiple young Iranian citizens by Iran's morality police. In addition, she reported on the work by Pepperdine University to help Uganda build and improve its judicial system. She showcased some gifts that were given to the City by Uganda officials during a recent visit to the area.

- i. Presentation by LA County Sheriff's regarding Fentanyl crisis affecting youth

Sheriff deputies Lee and Curiel presented information on the Good Samaritan law, fentanyl uses and its deadly effect, the slang names used for fentanyl, as well as what to do in situations with an overdose of fentanyl and how to administer Narcan, the reverse drug when exhibiting signs of overdose, such as sleepiness, pale skin, and faint and slow breathing. Deputies also provided an update on deaths in the local area as a result of fentanyl.

ii. Public Service Announcement on Fentanyl

Ideas for short PSA regarding the effects of fentanyl were discussed by MYC members.
