## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-1308**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA, PROHIBITING THE EXPENDITURE OF CITY FUNDS TO TRAP COYOTES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calabasas has a duty and responsibility to its residents to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calabasas desires to identify and achieve a balance between the importance of human safety and the native ecology of the region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calabasas resident or homeowner association can initiate, at their own expense, action to protect themselves and their property from coyote attacks.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The City Council of the City of Calabasas hereby prohibits the expenditure of city fund to trap coyotes.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or his/her designee to amend and update the plan as the city gains experience on this issue.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause the same to be processed in the manner required by law.
