ORDINANCE NO. 2001-159

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Section 36516 of the California Government Code, authorizing the City Council to provide by ordinance that each member of the City Council shall receive a prescribed salary, the amount of which shall be based upon the population of the City as determined by estimates made by the California State Department of Finance.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The official state estimate of population for the City of Calabasas made by the California State Department of Finance in May 2000 is between 20,000 and 35,000.
- Section 3. The salary of members of the City Council was first established in 1991 by Ordinance No. 91-9 at \$300 per month and has not been increased since that time. Section 36516(c) of the California Government Code provides that the compensation of members of the City Council may be increased by up to 5% per year from the date of the last salary adjustment.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Each member of the City Council shall receive as salary the sum of \$465.00 per month, as prescribed in Section 36516 of the California Government Code for cities up to and including 35,000 in population.
- <u>Section 5.</u> The salary prescribed in this Ordinance shall be exclusive of any amounts payable to each member of the City Council as reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by a member of the City Council in the performance of official duties or any other employment benefits permitted by law.
- <u>Section 6.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its passage and adoption pursuant to California Government Code § 36937 and shall supersede any conflicting provision of any City of Calabasas ordinance; however, the salary established by this Ordinance shall not be payable to members of the City Council until a member of the City Council commences a new term. It is anticipated that new terms shall commence following the March 6, 2001, municipal election.

<u>Section 7.</u> The Mayor shall sign this Ordinance and the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published or posted according to law.
