## II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

An attempt robbery was reported on Calabasas Road. The victim posted a watch for sale on a website and was contacted by one of the suspects. They agreed to meet in the parking lot of the location. When the victim was showing the watch to the suspect, the suspect attempted to grab it out of the victim's hands. The victim and suspect began to struggle. The second suspect pointed a handgun at the victim. The victim was able to get the watch and flee from the area. The suspects fled in a black BMW. (23-00830)

A commercial burglary occurred on Calabasas Road. A window was smashed to enter the restaurant. U.S. currency was stolen from the office area. These suspects, two males, were also responsible for committing six additional restaurant burglaries in Agoura Hills and one in Thousand Oaks during the same date frame. (23-00605)

A resident of Woodland Hills was arrested for prowling on Park Vicente. The victim saw the suspect looking into the residence on the home cameras. (23-00735)

Five thefts of catalytic converters were reported this month. The incidents occurred on Las Virgenes Road and Thousand Oaks Road. Vehicles targeted were between 2007 and 2012 Toyota Prius'. (23-00577, 00579, 00627, 00636, 00709)
