2. Adoption of Resolution 2023-751, approving File No(s). VAR-2023-001 and ZCL-2023-033, consistent with the Commission's direction on April 6, 2023.

"Furthermore, granting of the variance to accommodate the proposed retaining wall and attendant slope repairs and drainage features will not alter the fundamental drainage patterns of the applicable water sheds."

3. <u>File No. APR-2023-002, CUP-2023-001:</u> Request for a Conditional Use Permit and Administrative Plan Review for live music and the installation of permanent outdoor décor and faux foliage for Rose's Garden Bar, located at 26787 Agoura Rd E1 (APN: 2064-021-017 & 2064-021-018) within the Commercial Retail (CR) zoning district and Scenic Corridor (-SC) overlay zone.
