2. File No.SPR-2022-011: Request for a Site Plan Review Permit to construct a new 60'6" tall 118,495 square-foot mixed-use building titled 'The Park Apartments', inclusive of a 1,600 SF commercial space (counter-service restaurant) and 107 residential units, 26.25% of which will be designated affordable (16 units designated for low income households, 5 units designated for very low-income households). The project site is located at 24100 Park

Sorrento (APN: 2068-003-034) which is currently utilized as a parking lot for the Civic Center Complex, but also serves as shared public parking for all uses within the Park Center Master Plan Area. The site is located within the Commercial Mixed-Use (CMU) zoning district, and within the Affordable Housing Overlay (AHO) zone.

Additionally, provide cross sections through master plan area (Hilton Garden Inn, office buildings and City Hall), to show height of building within the context of its surroundings.
