PROPOSAL: Exterior paint selection for the Agoura Hills / Calabasas Community Center

Applicant: City of Calabasas

LOCATION: 27040 Malibu Hills Road

The Agoura Hills / Calabasas Community Center is a 30,000 square-foot facility that features a banquet hall, indoor basketball courts, exercise studios, gym, rental facilities and a rock climbing wall. Created as a Joint Powers Authority between the City of Calabasas and the City of Agoura Hills, the Community Center was constructed in 1999 and remained in operation until 2020. Since then, the Community Center has been closed for repairs and refurbishment. Work is currently underway to replace the metal barrel roof with a new roofing system designed to match the original green standing seam metal roof. The upgrades include repainting the exterior of the building, which is currently cinder block in various colors (beige, green and red).

Staff is requesting that the Architectural Review Panel comment on the color selection, identified in Exhibit B.
