ZERO-EMISSION BUS ROLLOUT PLAN RESOLUTION NO. 2023-1849

Background

- Innovative Clean Transit (ICT) Regulation (2019)
- Requires all public transit agencies to transition bus fleets to Zero-Emission technologies
- As a small transit agency, Calabasas is required to submit our ZEB Rollout Plan to CARB by July 1

Rollout Plan Guidance

- The plan must show a 100% transition by 2040
- Intended to be used by CARB and agencies to highlight challenges and find solutions
- Plan is a blueprint, not a binding agreement
 - Intended to be a living document, that changes as needed
- A guidance document was provided to help develop the plan
- Staff followed the guidance's structure



Calabasas Zero-Emission Bus Plan

- Agency and General Info
- Type of technology: Battery Electric Vehicle (BEV)
- Current Fleet: 12 shuttles, 1 trolley, 2 Vans
- Future purchases: 100% transition by 2034
- Infrastructure: Old Town, City Yard, more to be identified
- Workforce Training: Per Contract with Service Provider
- Funding Sources: Many current and future opportunities



Requested Action

- Approval of Resolution No. 2023-1849
- The plan must be approved by governing body (City Council) through resolution
- The resolution states that the plan has the aforementioned sections and follows CARB rollout timeline requirements
