PRESENTATION:

City Manager Kindon Meik will review the Law Enforcement Services Contract with the Public Safety Commission.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Calabasas contracts with Los Angeles County for municipal law enforcement services. The term of the current agreement is from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2024. The agreement may be renewed for another 5 years at the option of the County Board of Supervisors with the consent of the City.

Each year the City is able to set sheriff service levels in the community through the Service Level Authorization form or SD-AD-575. The City contracts for Deputy Service Units (minutes/hours not deputies). Deputy Service Units include indirect costs associated with law enforcement services (station leadership, dispatch, admin support, vehicle, etc.) The City may also contract for special assignment deputies and supplemental positions. Costs associated with deputies and other personnel are set by the County in the Master Rate Sheet that accompanies the SH-AD 575.

REQUESTED ACTION:

The Public Safety Commission will review and make recommendations as necessary.
