## II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A robbery was reported on Commons Way. The suspects, two females and one male, entered the business, selected store items, and exited without paying. One female suspect assaulted an employee when she thought the employee was attempting to stop the other female suspect. (23-03037)

A residential burglary occurred on Oak Ridge Terrace. The victim returned home and heard voices coming from upstairs. The victim yelled who was in the home and then fled outside of the residence. An upstairs master bedroom window was shattered to gain entry. The master bedroom was ransacked. No suspect description. (23-03270)  
An attempt garage burglary was reported on Towhee Drive. Video surveillance footage showed two males attempting to make entry into the garage. These same suspects committed a theft from an unlocked vehicle across the street from this location. (23-02778, 02779)

A resident of Palmdale was arrested for residential burglary that occurred on Prado De Las Uvas. The suspect had done some work at the residence for the victim. The suspect returned to the home on the pretense to change an air filter and stole jewelry from the master bedroom. Some of the stolen property was recovered. (23-03078)

An arson was reported on Freedom Drive. A vehicle was set on fire. During the investigation, the vehicle was discovered to have been stolen from James M Wood Blvd area in Los Angeles. (23-03195)


